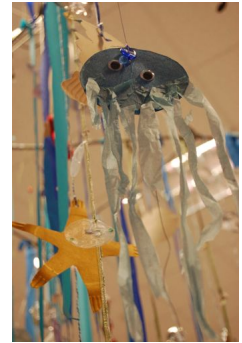
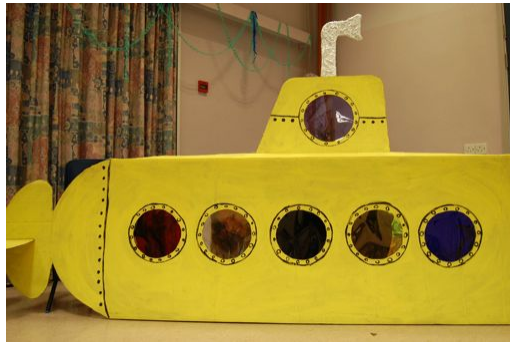


ROCKY'S Plaice
